## CGA Rules & Judges/Riders/General Membership Meeting Agenda for November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2012 Fresno, CA

**I. Opening & Introductory Comments** – Rick Long, welcomed everyone and turned the floor over to Andy Krogh, MAC Chairperson

**II. Rules & Judges Items (Voting – Rules & Judges)** *ALL CGA Members are invited to participate in this portion of the meeting, however ONLY Carded CGA Judges may vote on action items at this point.*

- A. **MOTION** by Dianna Malley, at any state sponsored show (State Championship, Jamborees and Classics) you must ride the division time in order to place in the division and to accumulate points toward high point, meaning if you don't run the division time you don't get the points for that division and subsequently the award. (For example, if you are signed up AAA and you run a AA time you will not get points or an award in the AAA division, you must run the time in order to place in the division.) Seconded by Belinda Harms **MOTION PASSED**
- B. In regards to the contrasting stripe around the barrel, **MOTION** by Dianna Malley to strike the requirement regarding a contrasting band/stripe around a barrel, seconded by Jeanette Stewart. Section 7.4 in Rule Book. **MOTION PASSED**

**III. New Business (Voting – All Members)** *ALL CGA Members are invited to participate in this portion of the meeting, all members 12 & over may vote.*

- A. Rick Long, President – welcomed members back to General Meeting.
- B. **Rules & Judges items for final vote.**
  - a. **MOTION** by Dianna Malley, at any state sponsored show (State Championship, Jamborees and Classics) you must ride the division time in order to place in the division and to accumulate points toward high point, meaning if you don't run the division time you don't get the points for that division and subsequently the award. (For example, if you are signed up AAA and you run a AA time you will not get points or an award in the AAA division, you must run the time in order to place in the division.) Seconded by Belinda Harms **MOTION PASSED** Discussion and vote. Call for the question by Christopher Rowles, seconded by Lea deMontigny. Vote taken, majority in favor, vote passed.
  - b. **MOTION** by Dianna Malley to strike the requirement regarding a contrasting band/stripe around a barrel, seconded by Jeanette Stewart. Section 7.4 in Rule Book. No discussion, vote by members. Vote taken, majority in favor, **VOTE/MOTION carries**.
- C. **MOTION** by Skip Hofman to change the age for the Senior Elite Program to 50 years old, seconded by Joanne Galbraith. Discussion and vote. Section 7.1 of Information Manual. Makayla Babiy called for question, seconded by Joanne Galbraith. Vote taken, majority not in favor, **MOTION FAILED**.
- D. Changes to points accumulation. **MOTION** by Andy Krogh that any points accumulation system can only be utilized if the computer software either has the capability to do the system or that any new system(not currently part of the computer program) will be implemented as soon as the software is updated. No hand calculations. This applies to only State Sponsored Shows, seconded by seconded by Melissa Krogh. Discussion and vote. Vote taken, majority not in favor, **MOTION FAILED**.

### **IV. Other Issues, Concerns & Comments (Non-voting)**

- A. Lea deMontigny questioned if lead line riders would be allowed to ride at state sponsored shows, even it was only 4-5 classes. Rick Long informed members that it could be directed to State Show Management or Board of Governors. Dianna Malley added that she would support seeing Lead Liners at State Sponsored shows.
