

Since there is no Northern Classic this year, we at District 49 have decided to have our own Memorial Weekend, three day show. We are proud & excited about holding this show so those riders who truly live in "Northern California" will have a chance to experience a larger over-night show without having to drive for hours & hours! We are fashioning it after the Classic format and if we have at least 55 riders, we will be able to offer \$200 hipoint & \$125 reserve in six divisions along with \$5.00 to every 1st place and \$2.00 to every 2-5th place. (We will also offer a special FC 15/under division with a lesser entry fee and less payout). (If less than 55 riders are signed up, then the hipoints will be reduced accordingly) If you like to camp with your horses and enjoy gymkhana, this is the show for you! Our arena grounds are beautiful with plenty of shade under the tall pine trees! We have an awesome snack bar and nice bathroom facilities and access to a children's playground and additional bathrooms. We have scenic trails above the arena and can easily ride our horses along the biketrail in Paradise if we choose. So you can camp, run events, trail ride, and have a great time with some great people on Memorial Day Weekend. We will have our entry form and flier available in the April CGA Newspaper so be watching for it. For further information or to get your entry form earlier, please see our website. We are trying to have riders pre-enter for this show so we can make any adjustments if necessary. There will be a \$15.00 late fee applied if you enter the day of the show, so mark your calendars and plan on spending Memorial Weekend with District 49!

Section 7: Senior Elite Awards Program

- **7.1 General** -The Senior Elite (SE) awards program is a modified version of the ROC program designed to provide competition and awards for the fastest and most accurate senior riders within the CGA (those 45 and older as of Jan 1st of the current show season). To be eligible for this program, the rider must provide proof of age, and the horse/rider combination cannot be signed up for the ROC program in the same show season. Proof of age need not be the person's actual age, only a certificate from a Doctor stating they are over the age of 44 as of Jan 1st of the current show season. This program is for horses only (no pony divisions). The number of possible awards for a given rider is extensive and is described in the following paragraphs. The **SE registration fee is \$80.00.** NOTE: **Fees are not refundable see Section 3.6**
- **7.3.1 SE Champion In Each Event** There is an SE Champion in each of the thirteen (13) individual events. A rider's time in an event is the average of his/her best three runs in the event during the show season. The rider with the best average time in the event is the SE Champion and will receive an SE jacket. The second best average will receive a Reserve Champion SE Jacket.
- **7.3.2 SE Yearly Record Holder In Each Event** -There is a Yearly SE Record Holder in each of the thirteen (13) individual events. Beginning with the first show after the Annual State Championship Show in August, the SE time run in each individual event at the first show will establish the initial SE record for those events. These records are generally improved as the show season progresses. The rider of each event who has the fastest time at the close of the show season will be honored as the SE Yearly Record Holder. Each SE Record Holder will receive an inscribed medallion for each record held.
- **7.3.3 Senior Elite Hall Of Fame** -The ultimate achievement for an SE rider is to ride to the Senior Elite Hall of Fame. Any SE rider who during the show season becomes AAA+ rated in ten (10) of the thirteen (13) events using the SE Matrix will be entered into the CGA Senior Elite Hall of Fame. They will receive a special Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle and a framed picture at the CGA Annual convention. In the event the rider does not earn a Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle, the rider will be eligible for the Level 1 Award using the normal Rating Matrix
- **7.3.4** CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten Riders -The CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten Riders will be determined by the following method: the rider's fastest 3 rides in each event are averaged. The 10 riders in each event with the fastest average will be given points as follows: 1st = 11 points; 2nd = 9 points; 3rd = 8 points; 4th = 7 points; 5th = 6 points; 6th = 5 points; 7th = 4 points; 8th = 3 points; 9th = 2 points; 10th = 1 point. Points from all thirteen (13) events will be added together, and the ten riders with the most points will become a member of CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten. Any ties will be broken by determining which rider has won the most first places. If the tie still exists, the rider with the most second places is selected. This process is continued, if necessary, to the place required to break the tie. Senior Elite Top Ten Riders must have an SE rating of at least AAA using the normal Rating Matrix. They will receive a special Senior Elite Top Ten buckle.

7.3.5 Senior Elite All Around Champion -The Senior Elite All Around Champion for will be determined by the following method:

- 1. The rider's fastest 3 rides in each event are averaged. The top five (5) riders with the fastest average in each event will be given points as follows: 6 points to 1st; 4 points to 2nd; 3 points to 3rd; 2 points to 4th; 1 point to 5th.
- 2. Points from all thirteen (13) events will be added together for each rider and the rider with the highest number of points will be declared the Senior Elite All Around Champion. Ties are broken by the procedure for breaking ties given in Paragraph 7.3.4. The Senior Elite All Around Champion will receive a special Senior Elite All Around Champion silver buckle.
- **7.3.6 Senior Elite Rating Matrix** The Senior Elite program uses a special SE Rating Matrix to determine a rider's eligibility for Senior Elite Hall of Fame. For Senior Elite Hall of Fame (Section 7.3.3) **only**, these times are considered AAA+ times. They are listed below:

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride - 40 % of the jackpot 2-D ride - 30 % of the jackpot 3-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot 4-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot 5-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot

CGA - None. All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
