PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Hello CGA,

We had our BOD meeting in February and I'm sure most of you heard that the major vote that took place was for the Newspaper to stop being printed. If you're reading this article then you have heard. But to let everyone know the truth about the paper instead of rumors going around. The paper is very expensive to print and we gave the option to the districts to bring back the monthly newspaper fee that they use to pay but for many districts that would mean that they would have had to raise their districts fee to their riders in order to cover their cost and most preferred not to raise their fees to their riders. So in order to not raise fees delegates and directors voted to keep the newspaper online only. The paper will still be done like normal with districts sending in articles and everything else that is published in the paper it just won't be printed and you will have to print it yourself from the web page. Now if some are upset over it then you need to find out if your district delegate were there. There were many delegates that did not show up so if one was your district then you had no vote on this issue. District delegates really need to attend the BOD meeting if yours is not then you need to find out why and maybe pick another one. The newspaper issue will be revisited at the BOD meeting at state show.

We are making changes to the web page to get more information out there since the paper won't be printed. If you have been looking at the web page you will notice the entry forms for all classics are online now and the worker lists for each show are online now so you can let the appropriate people know what you want to work ahead of time.

I appointed Shannon Rahn as Northern Vice President for the balance of this ride season.

Don't forget to sign up for Jamboree and Classics. Jamboree has no deadline for pre entry But Classics do so sign up early so you don't take a chance of a late fee.

Districts need to sign up for their event at state show. The worker list is online to see what events are still open. You need to contact Patrick Hoffman to sign your district up. This is a requirement of your contract as a district to work an event. If you don't have enough people to work an event you need to let Patrick know as soon as possible and he might be able to put you in contact with another district with the same problem.

Don't forget riders you have to be rated this year for state show and Classics are a good way to do that.

The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

If anyone has questions concerning this ruling you may contact the Rules Chairman, Shannon Rahn 209-712-5150.

There have been a lot of dress code questions lately, so I thought I would address the dress code in general.

When CGA was founded in the early 1970s, the founders wanted us to stand out as well dressed, nice looking gymkhana riders. There were other gymkhana clubs, but they wanted CGA to look and be the BEST!

Rule Book section 3.1 Clothing and Tack

The high standards of Gymkhana will be reflected by the rider's full and proper dress as follows:

a. **CLOTHING:** A Safety Helmet (hard hat) is required when riding any CGA event, unless the adult rider (18 or over) signs a waiver that indicates refusal to wear a safety helmet. An approved Safety Helmet is required for all riders under the age of 18. The helmet must be correctly worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Failure to do so will result in disqualification. If a helmet comes off while an adult rider is on course, a 1 second penalty will be assessed.

Notice the bold print above - this means that it must fit properly and be adjusted correctly. You may not wear a hat, hood, ponytail, bun or anything else under your helmet. Your helmet should be down across the middle of your forehead, if your helmet is pushed way back off of your face - it is not being worn properly. A judge can warn or disqualify you for violation of your helmet fitting improperly or being worn incorrectly.

Clothing shall be neat and clean, either Western or English riding attire, but not mixed, except where required for safety (i.e. hard hat). All contestants shall be fully attired in a dress shirt with a button or snap closure in the front from top to bottom, a collar, long or short sleeves (female contestants may wear sleeveless shirts), long pants, belt and boots. The sleeves on long-sleeved shirts must be rolled down and fastened at the cuff. Shirts must be tucked into the pants. Only the two buttons at the top of a shirt may be left unbuttoned. A tie or neckerchief is not required but their use is encouraged.

Notice the bold print above - this means no stained or torn clothing, if it has holes or rips don't wear it! A judge can warn you, penalize your time or disqualify you for violations.

All articles of clothing shall be properly worn, however buckles may be worn at the side or back for comfort reasons. Chaps may be worn. A Western hat may also be worn but a means must be devised to keep it on while running the course. If the Western hat hits the ground while the rider is on course, it will result in a one (1) second penalty.

Notice the underlined print above - this does not mean you can wear anything else over your long pants. For example sweats or coveralls. If you are cold you can wear long johns under your pants or chaps over, nothing else.

Notice the bold print above - No hats other than a helmet or Western hat may be worn while in the arena. This means no ball caps, visors, beannies, hoods or any other hat. A judge can and will penalize your time for violating this rule.

Note - a head band is not considered a hat, it is considered a hair accessory and can be worn alone, but not under a helmet.

Rule book section 5.2 Proper Dress and Equipment (Penalties)

a. A one-second penalty will be added to the time of any rider who enters the arena with attire and/or equipment in violation of the rules (refer to Section 3.1). An

exception may be given to new riders attending their first show providing prior approval has been obtained from the horse show management and judge. The new rider exception does not apply to State Show. In addition, a rider may be given an exemption for medical reasons providing safety is not compromised. The existence of a Doctor's note does not automatically grant an exemption. The final decision belongs to CGA, and the judge may decide that the situation would be unsafe. Any ambiguous situations should be referred to a CGA Master Judge and/or the CGA Rules Committee.

b. The dress code is in effect and must be adhered to during the running of any CGA events, whether those events are regular events, setups or schooling rides. A rider's obvious disregard for this dress code will preclude that rider's participation in the event.

Notice the underlined print above - this means if you only came to ride one event as a schooling run, you still have to follow the dress code.

Notice the bold print above - this means that you will be disqualified if you continue to violate the same rule. If a judge gives you a one-second penalty and you come in the arena again with the same violation you will be disqualified.

The idea is to take some pride in yourself and your membership in CGA and look nice, that is what the dress code rule is all about.

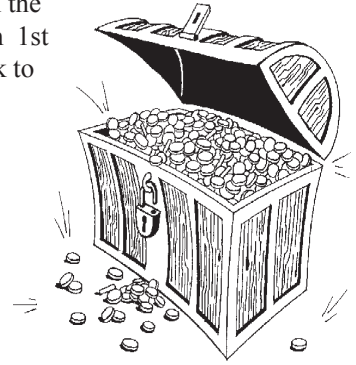

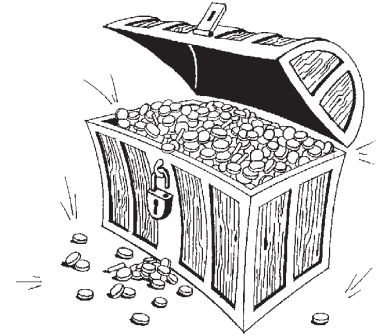

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
