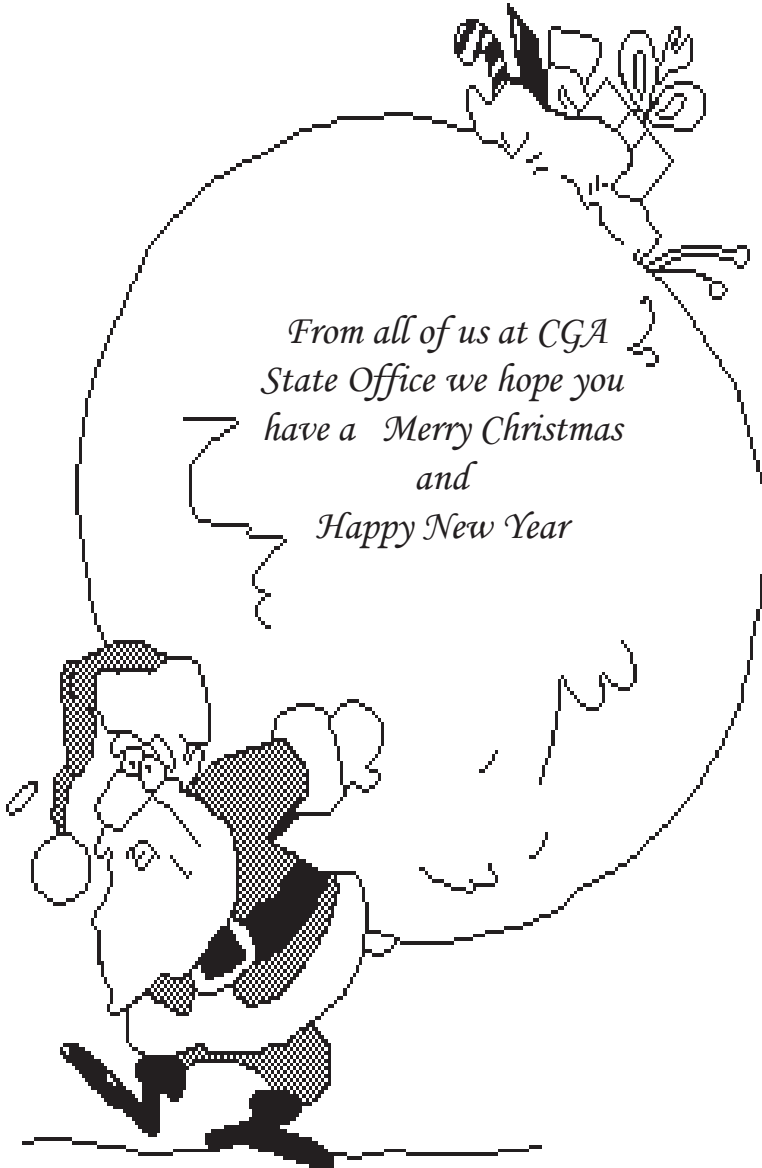

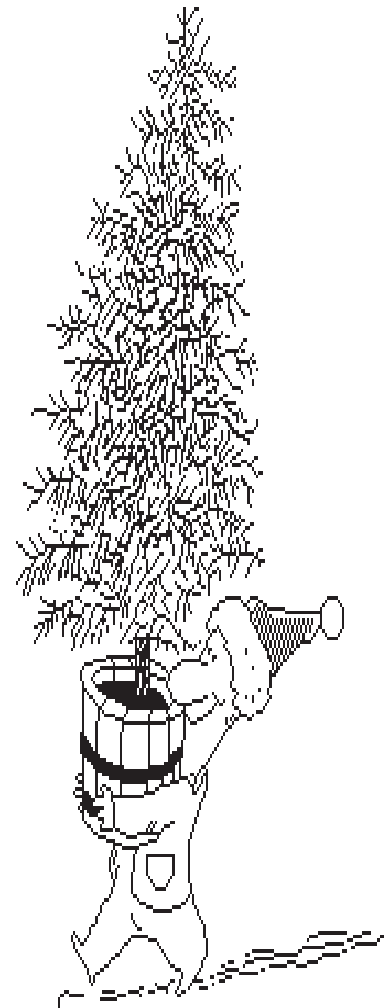

## The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

Q - I was wondering if you can clear up the rule about ties and tie breakers and how the rules of most first places wins was ever brought about and how this is applied to local districts. Can a local district adopt the "most first place's" rule?

A - Not necessarily, according to the rule book, if a competitor wants to run off a tie then it must be run off. Rule Book - Timing 7.1.d Ties: A tie may be settled by any method that is agreeable to horse show management and all tied competitors. However, the riders must run off the tie if any of the tied competitors wish to, or forfeit the prize for that place. Times from a runoff are NOT reported to the CGA office.

Q - It is my understanding a judge can not have a chair or any other object to sit on while judging.

A - Information & Regulations section 10.5 Judge. The Judge has total control of the activities in the arena. The Judge generally knows more about the rules and the CGA procedures than most other individuals. All Judges MUST be a fully carded CGA Judge. The Judges decisions are final. Judges should keep up to date on all approved changes in the rules that are not currently published in the CGA Rules Book. An apprentice judge must judge under the direct supervision of a carded judge. The judge must stand in the arena at all times while judging. It is impossible to properly judge a show without giving continuous and full attention to all activities going on within the arena.

Q - We have a question from a few in our club about where you can or cannot set the timing poles. We had our head judge set the timing poles on the fence line at the last show when we were running Single Stake. He put one of them right on the fence line. Riders complained about it. Also, the Single Stake was about 16 feet off the fence and two fences. What is the ruling on this?

A - It is legal to set the timing pole on a fence and it is also legal to put the single stake 15 feet off the end or side fences. I don't see the point in running it in the corner, but there are no rules against it. If the ground in the rest of the arena was unsafe, there might be cause. Otherwise the fair thing to do for all riders (regardless of the direction they turn the obstacle) would be to move it further from the fence.

Q - A member asked now that she was 18 does she have to wear a helmet? She was told because she was riding in the 18 and under division she must wear a helmet or she must move up to the adult division. The member chose to ride in the adult division. Is this a club decision?

A - No, this is not a club decision. Riders do not have to wear a helmet once they have reached their 18th birthday and they sign the waiver on the entry form. If your district runs age divisions, the riders should be required to ride in the appropriate division. If your club wants a division or class to all be required to wear helmets, they would have to change their age group to 17 and under. (there could still be a problem if a rider qualified in the 17 and under class due to their birthday being after January 1st and they then turn 18 during the year, they would no longer be required under CGA rules to wear a helmet.

Q - When wearing a zip up jacket is it a rule that the jacket must be zipped up? In the rule book just states clothes must be worn as intended. Would like clarification as members were being penalized.

A - No, there are no specific requirements regarding outerwear. The only requirements are that shirts be buttoned or snapped except for the top two.

## Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

### For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

**Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots**

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
