before July 3, 2009**

Avoid the \$5 Add-on penalty by adding all the events you intend to ride before July 3, 2009. There will be no penalty for Team Events or adding Jackpots at the show. **Also, remember there are no post entries.** If your entry isn't postmarked by July 3, 2009 you cannot ride in the State Championship Finals.

State Show Early Arrival Information Important - Please read

The CGA Office will **NOT** mail early arrival permits for camping and stalls to those that have paid for them. You will pick them up at the gate when you arrive. Bolado Park will not allow anyone onto the grass **before July 21, 2009**. If you are planning to arrive before July 21st. you will need to stay in the upper parking lot until July 21, 2009. The gates will be closed each evening at 5:00PM and will not be opened until 8:00AM. Please plan your travel time to arrive during normal park hours. CGA doesn't have the facilities officially until Friday morning, July 24th and we cannot make arrangements to have the gates remain unlocked prior to that date. Please make sure that you plan to arrive at the park during normal hours so you will be able to unload your horses.

CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. Some of the questions that have come up recently...

Q - Didn't we change the wording for lead line leaders so that it does not have to be an adult leading?

A - Yes! - After lots of research we came up with the minutes from the General Membership meeting held in 2005 and we did in fact strike the word adult from the rule! In the latest rule book revision 5/28/09 (posted on the web page) you will read the rule as it is currently.

2.3 a. A rider may be led through the course by a parent or responsible party provided the rider is not able to complete the course without assistance. (This means that it is up to the parent or guardian of the lead liner to decide who is "responsible" enough to lead the rider.)

Q - Are the electronic timer display boards allowed in CGA?

A - Yes, there are several districts using these display timers. There have been some ideas brought to the Board of Directors about utilizing them at State Show.

Q - If a rider arrives at a show and missed an event he/she needed, is it OK for the district to reset up the event for them?

Q - Are riders allowed to run a schooling ride during a set up event?

A - Yes to both of the above questions. Remember districts can set their own policy as long as they don't violate any CGA rules.

Section 1

Horse Show Management Ground Rules Ground rules may be used to state requirements in addition to those specified by the California Gymkhana Association. However, they shall not be in conflict with the rules of the CGA.

Q - Is it a CGA rule that all equipment has to be stored outside of the arena?

A - No.

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
