## The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

If anyone has questions concerning this ruling you may contact the Rules Chairman, Shannon Rahn 209-712-5150.

There have been a lot of questions recently regarding Lead Line, so again I am going to discuss the topic in this month's article. The lead line rules will be on the agenda at the Rules and Judges meeting at this year's Convention in November, so if you are unhappy or concerned with any of the rules, you should attend to have your voice heard! While lead line is a very small percentage of our rider base, it seems to bring up a lot of controversy. Let me see if I can clear up any discrepancies and misunderstandings. Some of the questions that have come up lately are:

Is there an age limit on a lead line rider? Answer - NO

Can a responsible 17 year old lead a rider? Answer - NO

If the leader is wearing a visor does that mean the rider gets a 1 second penalty?

Answer - NO

If the leader is under 18 and they are considered a team, does that mean the leader has to wear a helmet? Answer - the leader is not allowed to be under 18 and NO the leader is not required to wear a helmet.

Does the leader have to stay in the throat of the keyhole while leading the horse?

Answer - YES

If the lead line rider cannot reach the stirrups on the saddle, are buckaroo stirrups required? Answer - NO, the only special tack requirement is the addition of a halter and lead rope.

The rule book states the following:

2.3 Special "Lead Line" Rules for Young and/or Handicapped Persons

The CGA is interested in providing an opportunity for young and/or handicapped persons to participate in CGA Shows. For this reason, the following special rules shall be applied at CGA Shows that allow participation of these riders:

a. A rider may be led through the course by a parent or responsible party provided the rider is not able to complete the course without adult assistance. Such assistance is allowed to ensure the safety of the rider but does not extend to the assistant touching the poles, flags or other obstacles. The assistant must conform to the same dress code defined for judges (See Section 6.1).

b. Hard hats are mandatory for all Lead Line riders. The animal being led shall be in normal tack with the addition of a halter and lead rope.

c. Lead Line riders may NOT participate in the Hurry Scurry event for safety reasons.

d. A mount may NOT be entered in the same event more than once except as a Lead Line entry.

e. Lead Line riders may proceed no faster than a trot or they will be disqualified.

f. When leading the animal across the timing line, the assistant must be at or behind the shoulder of the animal to prevent any timer malfunctions.

First of all, the question of who is eligible to ride lead line - The Master Judges Advisory Committee (MAC) has discussed the topic and has decided that since there is no specific age limit, and that any rider that feels they are unable to complete the course without adult assistance is eligible to be lead.

That brings up the second issue - who can lead a rider? Per the wording in the rule book any parent or responsible party 18 years or older may lead the rider through the course.

That person must conform to the same dress code as CGA judges - this is the same

as the rider with the exception of foot wear and head gear. 1. Helmets are not required. 2. The requirement to wear boots is waived and the leader may wear comfortable Closed toe shoes. 3. The leader may wear a visor or any appropriate headgear to protect themselves from the sun.

The third issue is simple - don't forget that all lead line riders must wear a helmet regardless of age.

Forth - the horse shall be in normal tack with the addition of a halter and lead rope. The halter may be over or under the bridle.

Fifth - no lead rider may participate in Hurry Scurry.

Sixth - a horse cannot be entered in the same event more than once unless it is used in lead line. This means that a horse can ride in a regular division with one rider and be entered in lead line with another rider OR it can be entered in lead line with more than one rider.

Seventh - if a lead line horse breaks into a canter at all the judge must no time the ride. No judge wants to give a lead line rider a no time, but that is the rule! It is the responsibility of the leader to keep the horse at a trot or slower.

And Eighth - the leader must stay at the shoulder of the horse while crossing the timing line both at the start of the event and the conclusion. As of last Convention there was a rule change that has not yet been printed but is in effect. The leader/horse/rider are a team and the "team" must complete the prescribed pattern correctly - this means that the leader must stay in the keyhole just like the horse and must go around all the obstacles correctly.

\*\*\*\* Please remember that each district can run divisions how they see fit. They do not have to have a lead line class. The lead line class can be for regular awards or special lead line awards. The districts cannot violate a CGA rule and CGA does not dictate how they divide competition.

The Family Team Award is a Special Jacket for each team member embroidered with the riders first name and rating division on the front. The back of the jacket will have a barrel racer figure (male or female) and the last name of the "family" above the words "Family Team Member". All jackets within a "family" must use the same last name. Teams may consist of parents, children, grandchildren, cousins, aunts, uncles, or any other *relatives* so long as the last name is the same.

All riders on a "team" must earn at least a FC rating in order to qualify for the jacket. That means that all the riders on the team must complete at least 3 good rides in at least 4 events to qualify for the Family Team award.

Each team member's jacket will reflect their own rating level and each member will receive their own rating level for the year end award that is included in the \$100.00 fee.

This is a great way for the entire family to participate and work towards an award that they can wear with pride.

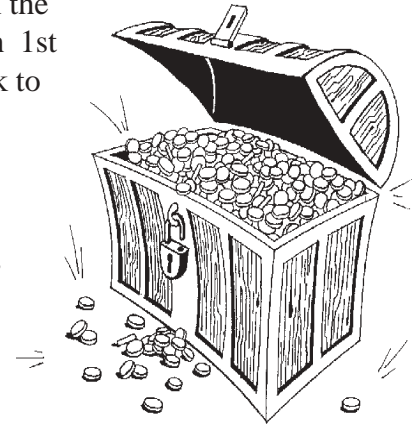

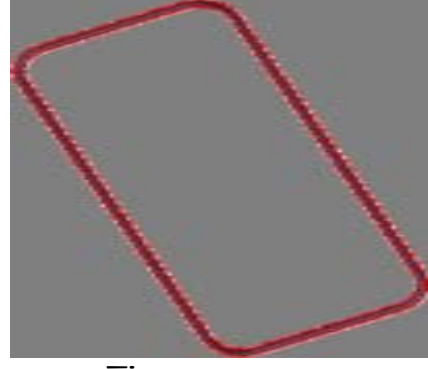

## Explanation of 5-D Jackpots For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

**Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots**

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
