Family Team Award

CGA is a Family organization and in recognition of the many families that ride together in CGA we offer a Family Team Award available to all riders regardless of ability.

The Family Team Award is 60 days retroactive from the date of the postmarked application or the show date if applicable. The \$120.00 fee per rider includes the Year End Award Level 1, Silver Buckle, Silver Breast Collar Set. For an additional \$20 the applicant can include both Level 1 & 2 Year End Awards.

The Family Team Award is a Special Jacket for each team member embroidered with the riders first name and rating division on the front. The back of the jacket will have a barrel racer figure (male or female) and the last name of the "family" above the words "Family Team Member". All jackets within a "family" must use the same last name. Teams may consist of parents, children, grandchildren, cousins, aunts, uncles, or any other *relatives* so long as the last name is the same.

All riders on a "team" must earn at least a FC rating in order to qualify for the jacket. That means that all the riders on the team must complete at least 3 good rides in at least 4 events to qualify for the Family Team award.

Each team member's jacket will reflect their own rating level and each member will receive their own rating level for the year end award that is included in the \$120.00 fee.

This is a great way for the entire family to participate and work towards an award that they can wear with pride.

Sign up today so that your family doesn't lose any rides. This is a fun award to earn and a great way to enjoy gymkhana with your family.

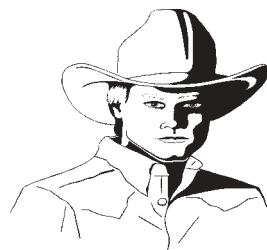

The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

This will be my last Judges Corner as the MAC will be turning over the reins of Rules Chairman to a different Master Judge after the Board of Directors meeting at Convention. It has been my pleasure to serve CGA as the Rules Chairman since July 2008. I enjoyed my duties, but feel it is time to let someone else have the fun for a while. Thank you all for your questions for the past two and a half years, it was never dull!

Here are the latest questions that were received:

Q. - Is it acceptable for a district to only offer Hurry Scurry or any other event as a set up only and never have it count for day end or year end awards at the district level?

A. - No. Information & Regulations manual 9.3 (1) be willing to schedule at least 7 shows with at least 6 events per show over a 12 month period and run all 13 events at least 4 times each. The MAC discussed this at the July meeting at State show and decided that offering an event as a set-up only is not in compliance.

Q. - Are the Ariat brand "Horseshoes" legal to wear in CGA?

A. - No, they do not meet the requirements as stated in the Rule Book 3.1 A boot is defined as either a traditional Western, traditional English, or roper style boot that laces up that is minimum of 1 1/2" above the ankle. All other boots must be approved by the CGA Rules Committee. All boots must have at least a 1/2" heel and a smooth sole. Patterned soles are permitted if the pattern is 1/8" or less deep. "Waffle" soles are specifically prohibited.

Q. - In Figure 8 Flags can you use the flag as a crop and smack the horse on the haunch?

A. - No. Rule Book section 8.4 Figure 8 Flags: Special penalty: The rider will be disqualified for knocking over a pail, or for using the flag as a club or bat.

Q. - In Speed Ball, if the rider puts the ball in the cone but tips the cone and the ball rolls out, what is the call?

A. - No time. Rule Book section 8.4 Speed Ball: Special penalty: A rider will be disqualified if the golf ball does not go inside the cone or if the cone is knocked over. Any action by the horse or rider that causes the ball to be outside of the cone at the end of the ride shall be a "No Time" ride. The cone shall be set on flat ground with no openings underneath the edges of the cone. If the ball rolls out from under the cone because of uneven ground, this shall be considered an illegal course, and the rider shall be given a reride.

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None. All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.	

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
