#### Monday July 26th at State Show!!

CGA President Skip Hofman has declared Monday July 26th as "Tough Enough To Wear Pink Day". So don't forget to bring your pink shirts, tack, etc. to wear and support that special day.

#### Don't Forget Add all your State Championship Finals rides before July 3, 2010

Avoid the \$5 Add-on penalty by adding all the events you intend to ride before July 3, 2010. There will be no penalty for Team Events or adding Jackpots at the show. **Also, remember there are no post entries.** If your entry isn't postmarked by July 3, 2010 you cannot ride in the State Championship Finals.

#### State Show Early Arrival Information Important - Please read

The CGA Office will **NOT** mail early arrival permits for camping and stalls to those that have paid for them. You will pick them up at the gate when you arrive. Bolado Park will not allow anyone onto the grass **before July 19, 2010.** If you are planning to arrive before July 19 th you will need to stay in the upper parking lot until July 19, 2010. The gates will be closed each evening at 5:00pm and will not be opened until 8:00am. Please plan your travel time to arrive during normal park hours. CGA doesn't have the facilities officially until Friday morning, July 24th and we cannot make arrangements to have the gates remain unlocked prior to that date. Please make sure that you plan to arrive at the park during normal hours so you will be able to unload your horses.



The rain has finally started slowing down so hopefully everyone is able to get those much needed rides. A couple of reminders in regards to STATE SHOW, Districts make sure you have checked with Patrick Hoffman and signed up for your event at state show. Riders you must be rated in order to attend state show and entries are due JULY 3rd! You only have to be rated FC in order to ride. All dogs must have a rabies certificate brought with you to state show to turn into state office upon arrival or your dog will have to go home. This is a park rule not a CGA rule. Also remember if you are going to be having a golf cart at State Show you will need to provide proof of insurance.

Monday will also be Tough Enough to Wear Pink Day, so don't forget to pack your favorite pink shirts to wear on Monday. We will also be holding a raffle so if you have something new to donate that would be great.

Districts don't forget if you have to cancel a show you must notify state office by the Wednesday following the canceled show so we can notify insurance. Districts make sure and get your show packets into state office as soon as possible following your shows. The riders need these shows posted so state office knows if you're rated when your entries come in.

I believe most districts are able to have shows now so make sure and check the website for upcoming shows. A lot of districts will be holding multi day shows now due to summer and helping riders to get rated for state.

I wish everyone the best in getting those rides and don't forget to mail your entries for state Show by July 3<sup>rd</sup>.

CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

Q - Do the timing poles have the same specifications as a regular pole?

A - Yes.

Q - Once a pony has a permanent pony card - can they ever be remeasured?.

A-Yes. See Rule Book section 3.5

The final decision to certify an animal as a CGA Pony lies with the Master Judge measuring the animal. The Master Judge Advisory Committee reserves the right to revoke any pony status if a majority of them feels that circumstances have changed since the certification was granted.

Q - Are shirts with 3/4 length sleeves allowed?

A-Yes. See Rule Book section 3.1 All articles of clothing shall be properly worn...

# **Explanation of 5-D Jackpots For All CGA State Sponsored Shows**

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride - 40 % of the jackpot 2-D ride - 30 % of the jackpot 3-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot 4-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot 5-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot

CGA - None. All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
