Hello CGA,

Plans are under way for State Show, Northern Classic & Spring Classic and Jamboree was a successful show hosted by District 2 in Ceres, CA. I hope you are planning to attend one of the Classics as these are state sponsored shows ran by the local districts. The state sponsored shows cannot be successful without the riders attending and everyone at the shows working to help out. The success of these shows is what is used to help fund CGA, which in turn benefits the riders.

I'm sure almost everyone has heard what I did at Jamboree. If not I will tell you for those who do not know. The last event on Sunday I reversed the riding order, yes, the fast riders rode last and the FC riders started the event. Yes, I know I made a lot of you in attendance mad but by the same account I made a lot happy. The reason I did this is because on Saturday we had workers but not enough workers, we had the same people working every event all day long. Then there were riders who rode and then went back to camp or just watched but never worked an event, not even one event. If every rider would just work one event or split an event then everyone would have time to ride, relax and enjoy themselves and no one would get over worked.

I ask every rider, parent and spouse the next time you are at a district show please step up and offer your assistance, no one is asking for someone to work the whole show but everyone can work an event or split an event. That's all anyone running a show is asking for. So when you're at a show think about just stepping up and working an event. You can open the gate, work the arena, write times, bring out equipment, setup an event there are many things that everyone can help with.

Now, with that being said, Classic signups are under way. Northern Classic is at Bolado park in Hollister this year and Spring Classic is at Camp Pendelton along the coast again this year. Classics do have late fees if you don't register on time, so make sure and check the paper for the entry forms and get them in on time.

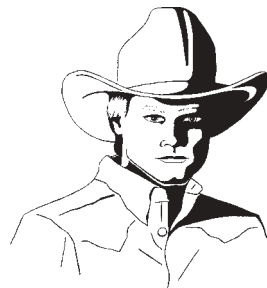

## The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

Q - If a horse is acting up prior to beginning an event and the rider dismounts for safety reasons are they allowed to exit the arena and come back in to attempt the course again?

A - Rule book 4.7 - The rider should not dismount at any time while in the arena without permission of the judge. However, if the rider dismounts for reasons of safety or reasons beyond their control, the judge's permission to dismount is implied.

As long as the judge did not feel the horse was out of control, they could move the rider down and allow them to try again.

## Family Team Award

CGA is a Family organization and in recognition of the many families that ride together in CGA we offer a Family Team Award available to all riders regardless of ability.

The Family Team Award is 60 days retroactive from the date of the postmarked application or the show date if applicable. The \$120.00 fee per rider includes the Year End Award Level 1, Silver Buckle, Silver Breast Collar Set. For an additional \$20 the applicant can include both Level 1 & 2 Year End Awards.

The Family Team Award is a Special Jacket for each team member embroidered with the riders first name and rating division on the front. The back of the jacket will have a barrel racer figure (male or female) and the last name of the "family" above the words "Family Team Member". All jackets within a "family" must use the same last name. Teams may consist of parents, children, grandchildren, cousins, aunts, uncles, or any other *relatives* so long as the last name is the same.

All riders on a "team" must earn at least a FC rating in order to qualify for the jacket. That means that all the riders on the team must complete at least 3 good rides in at least 4 events to qualify for the Family Team award.

Each team member's jacket will reflect their own rating level and each member will receive their own rating level for the year end award that is included in the \$120.00 fee.

This is a great way for the entire family to participate and work towards an award that they can wear with pride.

Sign up today so that your family doesn't lose any rides. This is a fun award to earn and a great way to enjoy gymkhana with your family.

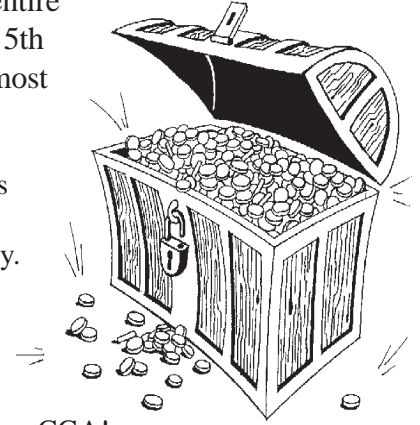

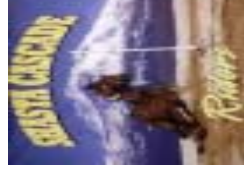

## Explanation of 5-D Jackpots For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

**Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots**

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None. All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.	

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
