Sunday more meeting, the districts up date were the best part of the meeting it's nice to hear all the good things you all are doing. Be sure to get a full up date from your district delegate.

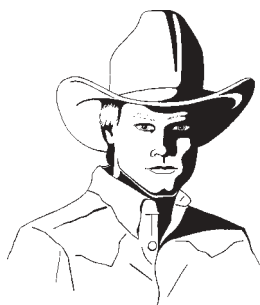

"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

Question: While riding in a split arena the rider falls off their horse into the other arena, but does not break the tape or knock down any delineators'. Is this a good ride?

Answer: No it is not a good ride. The rider gets a No Time in the event. While they didn't touch the tape, they broke the "line" of the arena boundaries, same as a horse jumping it. While we allow a rider the automatic permission to dismount if they fall in the arena they are competing in after they have crossed the timing line, this rider finished up in the other arena.

The loss of our Master Judge is a terrible blow to the many districts she served so well and to CGA in general. I offer my personal opinion here, not particularly the opinion of my home district or any other. There is something frightening about what appears to be a vendetta raised by those in power against someone who might have opposing views just as an elections is being held. I am even more concerned by all the secrecy that surrounds some of the BOG and BOD meetings and hearings. As a volunteer organization where all of us have a stake in how things are run secrecy needs to be eliminated. Being told that decisions "are none of the members business" is a slap in the face at those of us whose dues and rider fees are what support the organization. I would like to hear a logical argument in disagreement with my views. Perhaps there are things I don't understand, though with over half a century of memberships in dozens of different volunteer organizations, I would be quite surprised. Perhaps this letters to the editor section can be used as a forum for opinions. I can only hope so.

First of all Carole the Board of Governors would like to thank you for your opinions and concerns.

I would like to address each of your issues and concerns independently as you mentioned them in your letter

First of all I agree the loss of a Master Judge is a terrible blow to the organization, the districts and the membership. But regardless of how necessary the Master Judges are to the district and to the organization they too must abide by all CGA rules, policies and procedures as diligently, or more so than any other CGA member. I will agree that the timing of the hearing was unfortunate, but it was the events leading up to the hearing that drive the timing of the actual hearings. According to CGA Policies and Procedures, The Board of Governors are required to respond to allegations and formal complaints in a timely manner, Per sections 4 and 5 of the Board of Governors Procedure manual, so it was not a Vendetta as you called it or the election that determined the date of the hearing as many would like you to believe.

As far as "secrecy" there is nothing secret in this organization, especially with the social media of today. All Board of Directors meetings are open to all CGA members and guests, and the minutes from those meetings are posted online for all to see.

The Board of Governors however is a different story. The Board of Governors must deal with a lot of personal issues and according to Roberts Rules of order those meetings are considered Executive sessions are required to be held in confidence. Anyone attending those meetings as members of the board or guests are required to remain silent and can be, and have been, removed from office for divulging information coming from those meetings.

Your comment "are none of the members business" was taken out of context, I was the one who made that comment and it was made to a vendor at State Show that was also a member that was being very derogative and in my opinion making personal attacks on the Board of Governors. What I said was "it is none of your business" meaning it was none of her business. In hind sight I realized what I said was wrong, I was very angry at her over other issues, and it just hit me wrong. What I meant by my remark was that the decisions in question were the responsibility of the State Show managers and was not up for debate.

More FYI ; I was the one that started writing to the Editor column about 7 years ago. I started by writing in and asking questions under an assumed name and then answering them as the editor trying to generate some interest. I kept it up for about 6 months with no response, so I discontinued the article.

The Board of Governors would welcome any questions about the organization, that would be considered constructive, but we will not use the column as a bashing of the organization, its directors or its members.

Once again Carole, let me thank you for your concerns, I hope I have been able to answer your questions and concerns.

Lining up the members for the awards to be presented was Sheri & Danna Herchkorn, Morgan Easel and Jennifer Galindo-Cole. This is a huge job every year and these are the people that really make it run smoothly. Thank you all very very much. You know I couldn't do it without you.

Last but not least once again I would like to give a huge THANK YOU to my husband Rodger Odom for all you do behind the scenes all year, especially at Convention. I don't know where you get the energy.

## **Senior Elite Awards Program**

The Senior Elite (SE) awards program is a modified version of the ROC program designed to provide competition and awards for the fastest and most accurate senior riders within the CGA (those 45 and older as of Jan 1st of the current show season). To be eligible for this program, the rider must provide proof of age, and the horse/rider combination cannot be signed up for the ROC program in the same show season. This program is for horses only (no pony divisions).

The ultimate achievement for an SE rider is to ride to the Senior Elite Hall of Fame. Any SE rider who during the show season becomes AAA+ rated in ten (10) of the thirteen (13) events using the SE Matrix will be entered into the CGA Senior Elite Hall of Fame. They will receive a special Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle at the CGA Annual convention. In the event the rider does not earn a Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle, the rider will be eligible for the Level 1 Award using the normal Rating Matrix. If the rider does not also receive an Senior Elite Champion or Reserve Champion jacket, they have the option of receiving a Senior Elite Hall of Fame jacket instead of the Hall of Fame buckle.

### **Senior Elite Champion In Each Event**

The riders with the 1st and 2nd best average times in the event are the SE Champion and SE Reserve Champion, respectively. SE Champions and Reserve Champions will receive an SE jacket listing each event in which they are Champion or Reserve Champion.

### **Senior Elite Top Ten Riders**

The CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten Riders will be determined by the following method: the rider's fastest 3 rides in each event are averaged. The 10 riders in each event with the fastest average will be given points as follows:

1st - 11 points	2nd - 9 points	3rd - 8 points	4th - 7 points
5th - 6 points	6th - 5 points	7th - 4 points	8th - 3 points
9th - 2 points	10th - 1 point		

Points from all thirteen (13) events will be added together, and the Five riders with the most points will become a member of CGA's Senior Elite Top Five. Any ties will be broken by determining which rider has won the most first places. If the tie still exists, the rider with the most second places is selected. This process is continued, if necessary, to the place required to break the tie. Senior Elite Top Five Riders must have a SE rating of at least AAA using the normal Rating Matrix. They will receive a special Senior Elite Top Five buckle.

### **Registration and Fees**

The SE registration fee is \$120.00, which includes the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame award, but not the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite Rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Level 1 award.

Senior Elite riders may sign up for Level 1 and Level 2 awards for a fee of \$140.00. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame awards and the Level 2 award. A Senior Elite rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive both the Level 1 award and the Level 2 award. Fees are not refundable.

## Explanation of 5-D Jackpots For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

**Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots**

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None. All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.	

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
