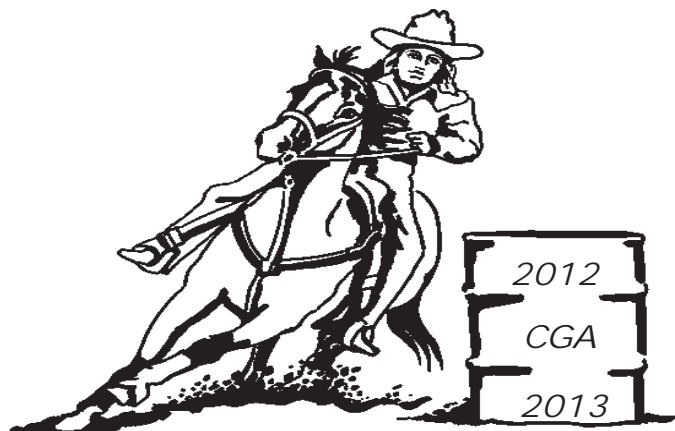

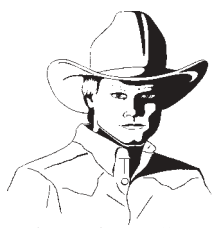

The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

Question: On keyhole a rider comes in and gets the OK to ride, once across the timing line the horse blazes past the left side of the keyhole without touching the line or going into the keyhole. At the far end of the arena the horse does a couple of circles and the rider gets it under control. They then walk back down the left side of the course almost to the timing line then turns and goes into the throat and then into the circle with all four feet, turns and walks out and across the timing line clean. Is it a good ride?

Answer: Yes it is a good ride. The rider was off course but corrected it. They did not incur the special penalty section of the keyhole rule. The intent of the special penalty is for once a rider has entered the throat of the keyhole.

8.4 Keyhole

Go through the timing line, run into the circle of the keyhole, turn in either direction, and return through the timing line. All four of the horse's feet must enter the circle. Special penalty: The rider will be disqualified if the horse's hoof touches the ground on or outside of any portion of the Keyhole (circle or wings).

Note: A penalty judge shall be stationed near the Keyhole and shall determine (by viewing hoof prints) the qualification of the ride. Such decision is final. One or more assistants shall be stationed near the Keyhole with rakes and will rake the disturbed area near the Keyhole as needed.

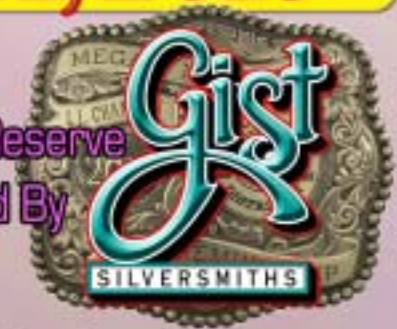

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
