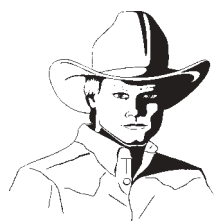

The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

If anyone has questions concerning this ruling you may contact the Rules Chairman, Andy Krogh 760-505-8241 andy@kroghwelding.com.

The December Judges Corner pertained to the Districts that want to run a Play Day. A District is allowed 1 Play Day a Show Season at which CGA will wave the minimum # of rides required to cover insurance. A Play Day does not count towards a Districts requirement to hold 7 shows per season with 6 events per show. A Play Day would be a Districts 8th plus show for the season (not necessary the 8th show in running order). At any CGA show ALL riders have to be CGA members.... This includes riders participating in a Play Day. In order to have a sanction show date, including a Play Day, the District is required to send those date into CGA 15 days in advanced for approval and insurance. At a Play Day Districts are allowed to have a show and run whatever events they want without sending any paperwork into CGA. The Question pertained to: Can the District run several Set-up events at a Play Day and do the necessary paperwork and pink sheets and send the forms and money into CGA and have the times count? The Answer is YES. The portion that pertains to Judges is that All riders that Participate in the events that will be counted for time, have to be run per CGA Rules...I.E. they have to be in correct dress, correct equipment, have a carded Judge in the arena for course set-up and be judged by a carded judge who is in correct CGA attire. Even if the participants of the play day were riding in non-CGA attire they would have to change and All aspects of the CGA Rules have to be followed for the riders setup times to count.

Family Team Award

CGA is a Family organization and in recognition of the many families that ride together in CGA we offer a Family Team Award available to all riders regardless of ability.

The Family Team Award is 60 days retroactive from the date of the postmarked application or the show date if applicable. The \$120.00 fee per rider includes the Year End Award Level 1, Silver Buckle, Silver Breast Collar Set. For an additional \$20 the applicant can include both Level 1 & 2 Year End Awards.

The Family Team Award is a Special Jacket for each team member embroidered with the riders first name and rating division on the front. The back of the jacket will have a barrel racer figure (male or female) and the last name of the "family" above the words "Family Team Member". All jackets within a "family" must use the same last name. Teams may consist of parents, children, grandchildren, cousins, aunts, uncles, or any other *relatives* so long as the last name is the same.

All riders on a "team" must earn at least a FC rating in order to qualify for the jacket. That means that all the riders on the team must complete at least 3 good rides in at least 4 events to qualify for the Family Team award.

Each team member's jacket will reflect their own rating level and each member will receive their own rating level for the year end award that is included in the \$120.00 fee.

This is a great way for the entire family to participate and work towards an award that they can wear with pride.

Sign up today so that your family doesn't lose any rides. This is a fun award to earn and a great way to enjoy gymkhana with your family.

CGA STATE SHOW QUEEN AND COURT - 2013

If you are a CGA member between the ages of 14 and 19 as of January 1, 2013 and have been a member in good standing for at least two consecutive years, you are eligible to be chosen as the new reigning Queen of CGA or one of the Princesses for the 2013-2014 Season

Your entry must be postmarked by June 1, 2013. CGA is not responsible for late arrivals. There is an Open Book Quiz that you must complete and send to the CGA Office.

All winners will be notified by mail and will
LEAD THE GRAND ENTRY AT THE STATE SHOW.

The Queen and Court are representatives at all CGA State functions and will receive a sash and a Silver Buckle. The Queen will receive a Silver Buckle, a silver hat tiara at the State Championship Finals 2013 and a rhinestone tiara at Convention 2013.

Check with your family. Make sure you are can attend the State show & Convention, send in your entry early, and GOOD LUCK to you!

Must be between 14 - 19 years old as of January 1, 2013
Must be a CGA member in good standing for at least 2 full, consecutive years as of January 1, 2013
Must pass an open book quiz of CGA information

There is a CGA Board of Directors meeting coming up on February 23, 2013 at the Holiday Inn in Visalia at 9:00 a.m. Try to make sure that your district delegate or representative is present at the meeting.

There just isn't much news to report when we haven't had any shows so I'll have to hope that I have something to write about by the next World of Gymkhana due date.

In the meantime don't forget that the Late Night Riders will run another 5 show Buckle Series with custom buckles in 7 Divisions and Lead Line too!!! The first Sat. show each month will count for the Buckle Series. If the first Sat. is rained out, the next Sat. show that month will count. If all the Sat. shows are rained out in a month the next Sat. show will count and if necessary additional shows will be added to make sure that there are a total of 5 Sat. shows in the Buckle Series. The sign up is only \$25 and must be paid but the second show in the series. The entry form is available online at: www.latenightriders.org

These buckles are custom ordered after the show series winners have been determined and include your name and your horse's name as well as the winning division. Last year every rider that entered the series received a buckle, a total of 21 winners. So sign up early and get one of these terrific buckles for your belt.

Friday night shows - Sign up at 6 p.m. ride at 7 p.m. and Saturday night shows - Sign up at 5:30p.m. ride at 6:30 p.m. All Day shows remain Sign up at 8 a.m. Ride at 9:15 a.m. We set the start time for Friday night at 7:00 p.m. in hopes of allowing everyone enough time to get home from work. Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
