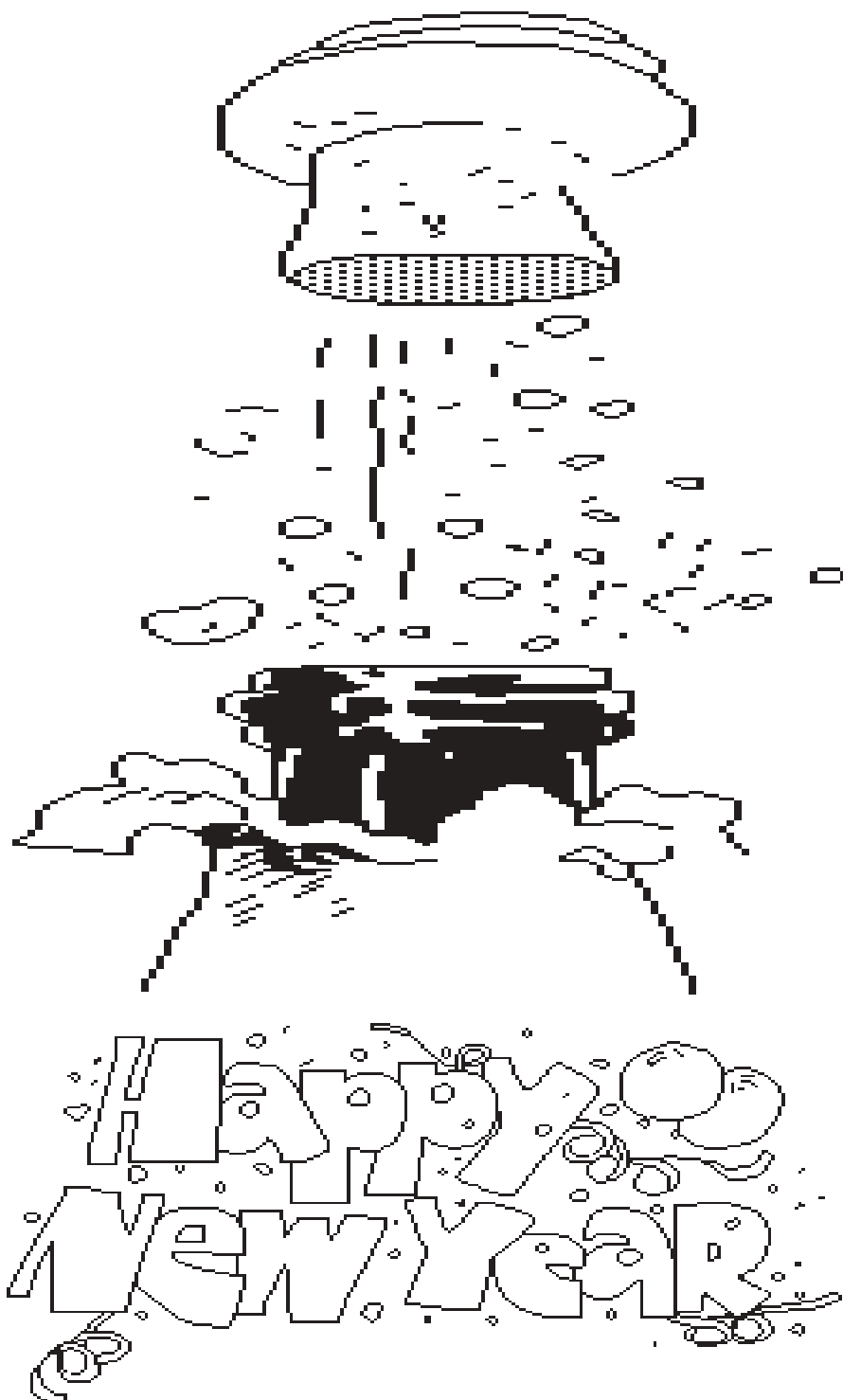

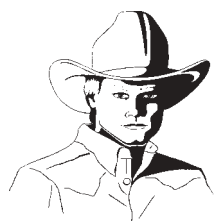

# The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

Question: I have a question regarding apprenticing judges? If you split the arena and have an apprentice in both arenas do you have to have a carded judge for both sides? Or can you have both apprentice stand in the middle next to the one judge?

Answer: Good Question.....but the answer is ; there has to be a carded judge in each arena to over see each ride and make sure each ride is correctly called by the apprentice judge in that arena. And per the Info book that carded judge has to be in that arena... not elsewhere.

### 10.5 Judge

The Judge has total control of the activities in the arena. The Judge generally knows more about the rules and the CGA procedures than most other individuals. All Judges MUST be a fully carded CGA Judge. The Judges decisions are final. Judges should keep up to date on all approved changes in the rules that are not currently published in the CGA Rules Book. An apprentice judge must judge under the direct supervision of a carded judge. The judge must stand in the arena at all times while judging. It is impossible to properly judge a show without giving continuous and full attention to all activities going on within the arena.

CGA Judges are not compensated for their work, they are volunteers. However, it doesn't hurt to buy them beverages and food to thank them for their efforts.

## Family Team Award

CGA is a Family organization and in recognition of the many families that ride together in CGA we offer a Family Team Award available to all riders regardless of ability.

The Family Team Award is 60 days retroactive from the date of the postmarked application or the show date if applicable. The \$120.00 fee per rider includes the Year End Award Level 1, Silver Buckle, Silver Breast Collar Set. For an additional \$20 the applicant can include both Level 1 & 2 Year End Awards.

The Family Team Award is a Special Jacket for each team member embroidered with the riders first name and rating division on the front. The back of the jacket will have a barrel racer figure (male or female) and the last name of the "family" above the words "Family Team Member". All jackets within a "family" must use the same last name. Teams may consist of parents, children, grandchildren, cousins, aunts, uncles, or any other *relatives* so long as the last name is the same.

All riders on a "team" must earn at least a FC rating in order to qualify for the jacket. That means that all the riders on the team must complete at least 3 good rides in at least 4 events to qualify for the Family Team award.

Each team member's jacket will reflect their own rating level and each member will receive their own rating level for the year end award that is included in the \$120.00 fee.

This is a great way for the entire family to participate and work towards an award that they can wear with pride.

Sign up today so that your family doesn't lose any rides. This is a fun award to earn and a great way to enjoy gymkhana with your family.

## Senior Elite Awards Program

The Senior Elite (SE) awards program is a modified version of the ROC program designed to provide competition and awards for the fastest and most accurate senior riders within the CGA (those 45 and older as of Jan 1st of the current show season). To be eligible for this program, the rider must provide proof of age, and the horse/rider combination cannot be signed up for the ROC program in the same show season. This program is for horses only (no pony divisions).

The ultimate achievement for an SE rider is to ride to the Senior Elite Hall of Fame. Any SE rider who during the show season becomes AAA+ rated in ten (10) of the thirteen (13) events using the SE Matrix will be entered into the CGA Senior Elite Hall of Fame. They will receive a special Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle at the CGA Annual convention. In the event the rider does not earn a Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle, the rider will be eligible for the Level 1 Award using the normal Rating Matrix. If the rider does not also receive an Senior Elite Champion or Reserve Champion jacket, they have the option of receiving a Senior Elite Hall of Fame jacket instead of the Hall of Fame buckle.

### Senior Elite Champion In Each Event

The riders with the 1st and 2nd best average times in the event are the SE Champion and SE Reserve Champion, respectively. SE Champions and Reserve Champions will receive an SE jacket listing each event in which they are Champion or Reserve Champion.

### Senior Elite Top Ten Riders

The CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten Riders will be determined by the following method: the rider's fastest 3 rides in each event are averaged. The 10 riders in each event with the fastest average will be given points as follows:

1st - 11 points	2nd - 9 points	3rd - 8 points	4th - 7 points
5th - 6 points	6th - 5 points	7th - 4 points	8th - 3 points
9th - 2 points	10th - 1 point		

Points from all thirteen (13) events will be added together, and the Five riders with the most points will become a member of CGA's Senior Elite Top Five. Any ties will be broken by determining which rider has won the most first places. If the tie still exists, the rider with the most second places is selected. This process is continued, if necessary, to the place required to break the tie. Senior Elite Top Ten Riders must have a SE rating of at least AAA using the normal Rating Matrix. They will receive a special Senior Elite Top Ten buckle of jacket.

### Registration and Fees

The SE registration fee is \$120.00, which includes the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame award, but not the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite Rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Level 1 award.

Senior Elite riders may sign up for Level 1 and Level 2 awards for a fee of \$140.00. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame awards and the Level 2 award. A Senior Elite rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive both the Level 1 award and the Level 2 award. Fees are not refundable.

We hope that everyone in CGA had a wonderful Christmas and a safe and Happy New Year. Wow, another new year already. I just can't believe how fast time goes by these days.

Well, the worst that could happen was that we would have our winter shows rained out and the worst seems to have happened. After two years in a row of very dry winters with well below normal rainfall, we took a chance and scheduled January, February and three March shows hoping to run if the dry winters continued. Nope - our Annual Turkey Trot and our Christmas show got rained out. Up here in the north we now have exactly twice as much rain to date as last year. Eighth inches compared to four inches and the arena has been flooded which didn't happen at all last year or the year before. So, it's not likely that we will be able to have the January shows BUT if the weather dries out we might still get in the February shows. We'll just have to wait and see.

In the meantime, everyone stay dry and dream about the nice warm days coming just around the corner. Before we know it - we'll all be complaining about the heat.

Don't forget that the Late Night Riders will run another 5 show Buckle Series with custom buckles in 7 Divisions and Lead Line too!!! The first Sat. show each month will count for the Buckle Series. If the first Sat. is rained out, the next Sat. show that month will count. If all the Sat. shows are rained out in a month the next Sat. show will count and if necessary, additional shows will be added to make sure that there are a total of 5 Sat. shows in the Buckle Series. The sign up is only \$25 and must be paid by the second show in the series. That means the second show that we actually run. Friday night shows - Sign up at 6 p.m. ride at 7 p.m. and Saturday night shows - Sign up at 5:30p.m. ride at 6:30 p.m. All Day shows remain Sign up at 8 a.m. Ride at 9:15 a.m. We set the start time for Friday night at 7:00 p.m. in hopes of allowing everyone enough time to get home from work. Also please check the Late Night Riders web site for "heat delay". When the afternoon temperatures are predicted to be over 100 degrees we will start at least 1/2 hour later than normal to try to avoid the worst of the heat for both the riders and the horses not to mention the workers.

## Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

### For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

**Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots**

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride - 40 % of the jackpot  
 2-D ride - 30 % of the jackpot  
 3-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot  
 4-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot  
 5-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot  
 CGA - None. All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
