## Don't Forget Add all your State Championship Finals rides before July 5, 2013

Avoid the \$5 Add-on penalty by adding all the events you intend to ride before July 5, 2013. There will be no penalty for Team Events or adding Jackpots at the show. **Also, remember there are no post entries.** If your entry isn't postmarked by July 5, 2013 you cannot ride in the State Championship Finals.

## State Show Early Arrival Information **Important - Please read**

The CGA Office will NOT mail early arrival permits for camping and stalls to those that have paid for them. You will pick them up at the gate when you arrive. Bolado Park will not allow anyone onto the grass before July 23, 2013. If you are planning to arrive before July 23 rd you will need to stay in the upper parking lot until July 23, 2013. The gates will be closed each evening at 5:00pm and will not be opened until 8:00AM. Please plan your travel time to arrive during normal park hours. CGA doesn't have the facilities officially until Friday morning, July 26th and we cannot make arrangements to have the gates remain unlocked prior to that date. Please make sure that you plan to arrive at the park during normal hours so you will be able to unload your horses.

## Monday July 29th at State Show!!



## The Judge's Corner



"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

### Question,

Could you clarify this for me. We have some young riders LL and FC. As you know the transition from LL to riding by yourself (FC) can be scary for both rider and parent. I want to confirm that if you start out as LL with a lead rope connected to the halter and go through the timers, you must finish with it connected at all times for a time, and at no time can you follow behind a FC rider on a course and get a time. I know sometimes you can have different rules for your dist., but I feel this would hurt the integrity of an official time. Where I think there is room for discussion and I remember this being talked about at state. I thought I heard you can not go pass the timing line if you are in the arena with a beginner rider. I also know you can lead them in with a lead rope and then let them go and when the judge feels they have control they will let them go. Where I am not sure is, I feel that it would be o.k for instance in F8S to go up and down the event never crossing over the timing line or encroaching into the event, basically if you take your timing poles and your obstacles and drew a line around the course and no one step inside the rectangle, could that be considered a good ride? At least at a dist. level. This would not work for barrels, but other shorter events if you draw the outside line you could stay close to a rider to build confidence while they learn to ride by themselves with out infringing on the actual course. Could this be considered a good time? Thank you

Lead line can be a tough class as you have the kids that want to do it them self, but they just don't quite have enough control. Per the Rulebook 2.3 the "lead line team" (horse, rider and leader) must complete the course.....that means the leader must maintain control of the leadline and be near enough to ensure the safety of the rider, they also must complete the exact same course that the horse is riding...the leader must go around every obstacle just as the horse does (no switching hands to let the horse go around pole and the leader on the other side...same as with barrels they must walk around the barrel not just put the leadline rope over the barrel and let the horse walk around it)....otherwise they are off course and a no time will be given. Also per the Rulebook 2.3 the leader must cross the timing line at the shoulder of the horse or behind...the leader should not be what is triggering the timer. Also the leader can not touch any of the obstacles (poles, flags, golf ball, ect..)

Rulebook 4.3 clarification...If it is a person helping the rider into the arena then the person may bring the rider all the way up to the timing line (if the district allows...no CGA rules against it) but the person has to let go of the horse and the rider has to show control of the animal prior to the judge giving them the ok to ride. The assistant can not go across the timing line.

There is no rules about where a "coach" can coach from....but if they lead the animal in then they can not go across the timing line.... no one should go across the timing line but the rider on horseback. If they would allow the coach in the arena then they could coach from inside the arena and parallel the horse (our district requires coaching from outside of the arena or from the gate to the starting line...makes it fair to all that are participating)...If at any point in time anyone touches the horse or rider while on course it is a no time.

\*\*\*\*Note\*\*\*\* Per Rulebook 2.3C NO Leadline Riders are allowed to participate in Hurry Scurry.\*\*\*\*\*

## **Senior Elite Awards Program**

The Senior Elite (SE) awards program is a modified version of the ROC program designed to provide competition and awards for the fastest and most accurate senior riders within the CGA (those 45 and older as of Jan 1st of the current show season). To be eligible for this program, the rider must provide proof of age, and the horse/rider combination cannot be signed up for the ROC program in the same show season. This program is for horses only (no pony divisions).

The ultimate achievement for an SE rider is to ride to the Senior Elite Hall of Fame. Any SE rider who during the show season becomes AAA+ rated in ten (10) of the thirteen (13) events using the SE Matrix will be entered into the CGA Senior Elite Hall of Fame. They will receive a special Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle at the CGA Annual convention. In the event the rider does not earn a Senior Elite Hall of Fame buckle, the rider will be eligible for the Level 1 Award using the normal Rating Matrix. If the rider does not also receive an Senior Elite Champion or Reserve Champion jacket, they have the option of receiving a Senior Elite Hall of Fame jacket instead of the Hall of Fame buckle.

## **Senior Elite Champion In Each Event**

The riders with the 1st and 2nd best average times in the event are the SE Champion and SE Reserve Champion, respectively. SE Champions and Reserve Champions will receive an SE jacket listing each event in which they are Champion or Reserve Champion.

## **Senior Elite Top Ten Riders**

The CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten Riders will be determined by the following method: the rider's fastest 3 rides in each event are averaged. The 10 riders in each event with the fastest average will be given points as follows:

1st - 11 points 2nd - 9 points 3rd - 8 points 4th - 7 points 5th - 6 points 6th - 5 points 7th - 4 points 8th - 3 points 9th - 2 points 10th - 1 point

Points from all thirteen (13) events will be added together, and the Five riders with the most points will become a member of CGA's Senior Elite Top Five. Any ties will be broken by determining which rider has won the most first places. If the tie still exists, the rider with the most second places is selected. This process is continued, if necessary, to the place required to break the tie. Senior Elite Top Ten Riders must have a SE rating of at least AAA using the normal Rating Matrix. They will receive a special Senior Elite Top Ten buckle of jacket.

## **Registration and Fees**

The SE registration fee is \$120.00, which includes the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame award, but not the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite Rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Level 1 award. Senior Elite riders may sign up for Level 1 and Level 2 awards for a fee of \$140.00. A Senior Elite rider that enters Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive the Hall of Fame awards and the Level 2 award. A Senior Elite rider that does not enter Senior Elite Hall of Fame will receive both the Level 1 award and the Level 2 award. Fees are not refundable.







## **Explanation of 5-D Jackpots For All CGA State Sponsored Shows**

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride - 40 % of the jackpot 2-D ride - 30 % of the jackpot 3-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot 4-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot 5-D ride - 10 % of the jackpot

CGA - None. All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
