ELECTIONS

ELECTIONS FOR CGA BOARD OF DIRECTORS WILL BE HELD AT CONVENTION.

The nomination period for the California Gymkhana Association's annual election of Officers and Directors ends 45 days prior to Convention. This year there are 4 Director positions available. Directors are elected for a two year term. The newly elected Directors will take office at Convention 2018.

Due to this deadline it is imperative that all nominations for Directors be received in the CGA Office in time to be published in the October and November issues of the World of Gymkhana. The deadline for publication in the October issue is September 10, 2018 and the November issue is October 10, 2018.

This is so those members of CGA who may not have a personal knowledge of each candidate will have some way of making a decision about who to vote for. All members are encouraged to contact any candidate and learn as much as possible about all the candidates prior to the election. Ballots will be mailed to all CGA members in good standing over the age of 12 who register with the CGA State Office for an Absentee Ballot. All other Ballots will be available November 3, 2018 at Convention, at the Double Tree Hotel in Fresno, CA.

The CGA Office will begin accepting nominations on August 5, 2018 and nominations will close on September 18, 2018. Any CGA member may nominate any qualified CGA member for any of the Officer/Director positions. Nominations must be dated and in writing, either regular mail, email or fax. The candidate must respond & agree to serve if elected. The nomination must be signed. Please submit a candidate's statement of 200 words or less indicating the qualifications, length of membership, reason for running for office and any other information that may help members decide to vote for the candidate. Candidates statements must be emailed. These statements will be included in the World of Gymkhana.

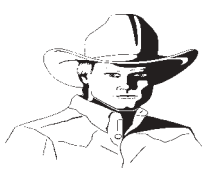

"The Judge's Corner" has appeared in this paper with a varying degree of regularity since 1991. CGA Judges, Members and Work Crew are invited to submit difficult calls or unusual questions that occur so that others can learn from their experiences. The best ones (unusual or just plain odd) will be printed here.

If you have input for this column, please send your question to the CGA State Office. Your question will be answered by a Master Judge and the Rules Chairman. If there is any disagreement, it will be submitted to the Rules Committee and MAC for final resolution.

At state show the mac allowed a 3/4 length sleeve to be a legal shirt.

At convention november 4, 2017 the clothing ref dress shirt was brought up to change it in the rule book. At the judges meeting it was voted down.

There is no change to the rule book

Rule book

3.1 Clothing and Tack

The high standards of Gymkhana will be reflected by the rider's full and proper dress as follows:

Clothing shall be neat and clean. All contestants shall be fully attired in a dress shirt with a button or snap closure in the front from top to bottom, a collar, long or short sleeves (female contestants may wear sleeveless shirts), long pants, belt or half belts and boots. The sleeves on long-sleeved shirts must be rolled down and fastened at the cuff. Shirts must be tucked into the pants. Only the top two buttons of the shirt may be left unbuttoned as long as the buttons go to the collar line of the shirt.

Family Team Award

CGA is a Family organization and in recognition of the many families that ride together in CGA we offer a Family Team Award available to all riders regardless of ability.

The Family Team Award is 60 days retroactive from the date of the postmarked application or the show date if applicable. The \$125.00 fee per rider includes the Year End Award Level 1, Silver Buckle, Silver Breast Collar Set. For an additional \$20 the applicant can include both Level 1 & 2 Year End Awards.

The Family Team Award is a Special Jacket for each team member embroidered with the riders first name and rating division on the front. The back of the jacket will have a barrel racer figure (male or female) and the last name of the "family" above the words "Family Team Member". All jackets within a "family" must use the same last name. Teams may consist of parents, children, grandchildren, cousins, aunts, uncles, or any other *relatives* so long as the last name is the same.

All riders on a "team" must earn at least a FC rating in order to qualify for the jacket. That means that all the riders on the team must complete at least 3 good rides in at least 4 events to qualify for the Family Team award.

Each team member's jacket will reflect their own rating level and each member will receive their own rating level for the year end award that is included in the \$125.00 fee.

This is a great way for the entire family to participate and work towards an award that they can wear with pride.

Sign up today so that your family doesn't lose any rides. This is a fun award to earn and a great way to enjoy gymkhana with your family.

Senior Elite Awards Program

The Senior Elite (SE) awards program is a modified version of the ROC program designed to provide competition and awards for the fastest and most accurate senior riders within the CGA (those 45 and older as of Jan 1st of the current show season). To be eligible for this program, the rider must provide proof of age, and the horse/rider combination cannot be signed up for the ROC program in the same show season. This program is for horses only (no pony divisions).

The ultimate achievement for an SE rider is to ride to the Senior Elite. Any SE rider who during the show season becomes AAA+ rated in ten (10) of the thirteen (13) events using the SE Matrix will be entered into the CGA Senior Elite. They will receive a special Senior Elite buckle at the CGA Annual convention. In the event the rider does not earn a Senior Elite buckle, the rider will be eligible for the Level 1 Award using the normal Rating Matrix. If the rider does not also receive an Senior Elite Champion or Reserve Champion jacket, they have the option of receiving a Senior Elite jacket instead of the buckle.

Senior Elite Champion In Each Event

The riders with the 1st and 2nd best average times in the event are the SE Champion and SE Reserve Champion, respectively. SE Champions and Reserve Champions will receive an SE jacket listing each event in which they are Champion or Reserve Champion.

Senior Elite Top Ten Riders

The CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten Riders will be determined by the following method: the rider's fastest 3 rides in each event are averaged. The 10 riders in each event with the fastest average will be given points as follows:

1st - 11 points	2nd - 9 points	3rd - 8 points	4th - 7 points
5th - 6 points	6th - 5 points	7th - 4 points	8th - 3 points
9th - 2 points	10th - 1 point		

Points from all thirteen (13) events will be added together, and the Ten riders with the most points will become a member of CGA's Senior Elite Top Ten. Any ties will be broken by determining which rider has won the most first places. If the tie still exists, the rider with the most second places is selected. This process is continued, if necessary, to the place required to break the tie. Senior Elite Top Ten Riders must have a SE rating of at least AAA using the normal Rating Matrix. They will receive a special Senior Elite Top Ten buckle or jacket.

Registration and Fees

The SE registration fee is \$125.00, which includes the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite rider that achieves Senior Elite will receive the Senior Elite award, but not the Level 1 award. A Senior Elite Rider that does not achieve Senior Elite will receive the Level 1 award.

Senior Elite riders may sign up for Level 1 and Level 2 awards for a fee of \$145.00. A Senior Elite rider that achieves Senior Elite will receive the Senior Elite awards and the Level 2 award. A Senior Elite rider that does not achieve Senior Elite will receive both the Level 1 award and the Level 2 award. Fees are not refundable.

Match Races! If you haven't seen match races yet, this alone should entice you to come to State Finals next year! Match races are the pinnacle of our season, what most people are hoping to accomplish, even more so than a placing or high point...match races are where the real competition happens and is SO MUCH FUN to participate in or watch. Each night, the top 16 riders from each event are 'auctioned off' in a calcutta and then compete in an elimination style running of the event, until there are only 4 riders left. Running the same event, side by side, four is then eliminated to two, and a 'Finals Heat' is run, determining the winner of the match race for that event. The winner takes home 40 percent of the pot, along with \$100 from CGA and a buckle, and the 'buyer' of the rider from the auction takes home 60 percent of the pot. It's the most fierce and most fun competition there is. Ask anyone, match races are our 'claim to fame' and is one reason CGA is so unique and unmatched, at our State Finals. Thank you to Conrad Fimbres and his family, for their support during match races and the rest of the week. If you don't know who Conrad is, one night at match races and you'll never forget his voice as he has become synonomys with match race announcing- 'Riders...the system is on...'

Also big Thank You to Nathan Rowles who, each night, hosts the calcutta, auctioning off the riders for sale in match races. He, along with his crew of numerous folks including, Chris Rowles, Roger odom, Timi Lemen and so many others, make sure riders are all purchased and money is collected.

Our CGA State Finals Fundraising crew was BETTER THAN EVER this year. Huge thank you to Amy Odom and Tiffany Martin who oversaw the Horse Plop fundraiser, raising over \$3600 for State Finals high point awards, along with the silent auction bringing in \$2200, the 50/50 raffle brining in \$995 and the the breast collar (beatiful, high quality leather with custom leather flowers, donated by Phyllis Odom) raffle brining in \$663. Ladies and Gentlemen....this is more than \$7000 raised, in one season, from just a few fundraising efforts! Thank you BIG TIME to everyone who donated baskets or items for the silent auction which were just too many to name as well as each district who participated in the District Challenge, to raise money for State Finals high point. So many districts came together, sending in a big, fat check to go towards awards. And lastly, thank you to District 1 who won the challenge!

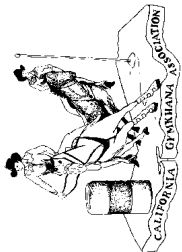

Explanation of 5-D Jackpots

For All CGA State Sponsored Shows

Note: District's may alter all the Jackpot options as they choose for local shows running jackpots or Mystery jackpots

Riders may optionally enter a jackpot for any or all of the regular events. The cost is an additional \$5.00 per event, and a rider may choose to enter the Jackpot for none, some, or all of the regular events. These jackpots are unrelated to the rider's division or age, and whether or not they are riding a horse or a pony. They are based strictly on the time the rider achieves in that event. *Only the times of the Riders entering the Jackpots count.* The size of the payout is determined by the number of riders in the jackpot. The Payout is:

Fastest ride	- 40 % of the jackpot
2-D ride	- 30 % of the jackpot
3-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
4-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
5-D ride	- 10 % of the jackpot
CGA - None.	All jackpot money is paid back to the riders.

2-D, 3-D, 4-D and 5-D rides are those that come the closest (*without going faster*) to the fastest time of those entering the jackpot +(plus) the adjustment factor for that event. The adjustment factors are listed below.

For example, if the fastest ride in Poles I was 10.990 seconds, and the jackpot was \$400.00, then that rider would receive \$160.00. The rider closest to the 2-D time of 12.524 (10.990 + 1.534) *without going faster* would receive \$120.00. The rider closest to the 3-D time of 14.057 (10.990 + 3.067) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 4-D time of 15.591 (10.990 + 4.601) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00. The rider closest to the 5-D time of 17.125 (10.990 + 6.135) *without going faster* would receive \$40.00.
