Enclosed you will find your application, rules, qualifications and quiz to become our Queen or one of the Queen's Court, a Princess for the 2024-2025 CGA season.

Please fill out the forms and complete the open book quiz and return to the State Office as soon as possible, but no later than May 01, 2024. Please include a clear, sharp, photo, 3"x5" or smaller with your entry. Your entry must be postmarked no later than May 01, 2024

All contestants will be notified if they are selected. Please make sure you will be able to attend both the State Championship Finals in Hollister, July 20 through July 26, 2024 and the Convention and Awards Banquet in Visalia on November 16, 2024.

If you live in the North half of the state you should plan to attend the Northern Classic in the year 2025 and if you live in the South half of the state you should plan to attend the Spring Classic in 2025. You should also be able to attend Jamboree in October 2024, assuming it is geographically close enough to you. Your reign will be from the beginning of State Show in July 2024 to the Saturday before State Show in July 2025.

CGA feels you will be an asset to the State Championship Show and will be an excellent representative of our organization if you are chosen as Queen or one of the Princesses.

We wish you the best of luck and remember - this is a drawing, so you have as much of a chance of being selected as anyone else.

CGA STATE CHAMPION QUEEN AND COURT 2024-2025 SEASON

If you are a CGA member between the ages of 14 and 19 as of January 1, 2024 and have been a member in good standing for at least two consecutive years, you are eligible to be chosen as the new reigning Queen of CGA or one of the Princesses for the 2024 - 2025 CGA season.

Your entry must be postmarked by May 1, 2024. CGA is not responsible for late arrivals. There is an Open Book Quiz that you must complete and send to the CGA Office. A drawing will be held to select the new Queen and Princesses.

All members selected will be notified and will LEAD THE GRAND ENTRY AT THE STATE SHOW.

The Queen and her Court are representatives at all CGA State sponsored functions and will receive a sash and a silver buckle. The Queen will receive silver buckle, a silver hat tiara at the State Championship Finals 2024 and a rhinestone tiara at Convention 2024.

Check with your family. Make **sure** you are going to attend the State show and convention, send in your entry early, and GOOD LUCK to you......
