- 3. When you sign up for the Race of Champions (ROC) program, you are also signed up for Level 1 Year End Awards, If you do not earn a Hall of Fame buckle, you will be eligible for he Level 1 award. You may instead select Level 2 or both. See fee schedule below.
- 4. The CGA Season begins with the first sanctioned show after State Championship Finals and ends with the last ride of State Championship finals the following year.

Any CGA ROC Awards application will count \underline{only} shows beginning $\underline{60}$ days prior to the postmark date until end of show season.
