Please fill out the forms and complete the open book quiz and return to the State Office as soon as possible, but no later than May 01, 2025. Please include a clear, sharp photo, 3"x5" or smaller with your entry. Your entry must be postmarked no later than May 01, 2025.

All contestants will be notified if they are selected. Please make sure you will be able to attend both the State Championship Finals in Hollister, July 19 through July 25, 2025 and the Convention and Awards Banquet in Visalia on November 15, 2025.

Additionally, If you live in the North half of the state, plan to attend the Northern Classic Memorial Day Weekend 2026 and if you live in the Southern half of the state, plan to attend the Southern Classic Memorial Day weekend 2026. You should also plan to attend Jamboree in October 2025, assuming it is geographically close to you. Your reign will be from the beginning of State Show in July 2025 to the Saturday before State Show in July 2026.

If selected, CGA feels you will be an asset to the State Championship Show and will be an excellent representative of our organization.

We wish you the best of luck and remember - this is a drawing, so you have as much of a chance of being selected as anyone else. However, you must first serve as a princess before being selected as the CGA Queen.

CGA STATE CHAMPION QUEEN AND COURT 2025-2026 SEASON

If you are a CGA member between the ages of 14 and 19 as of May 1, 2025 and have been a member in good standing for at least two years, you are eligible to be chosen as the new reigning Queen of CGA or one of the Princesses for the 2025 – 2026 CGA season.

Your entry must be postmarked by May 1, 2025. CGA is not responsible for late arrivals. If you choose to scan/email the email must be received by May 1, 2025. There is an Open Book Quiz that each applicant must complete and send to the CGA Office. A drawing will be held to select the new Queen and Princesses.

All members selected will be notified and will LEAD THE GRAND ENTRY AT THE STATE SHOW.

The Queen and her Court are representatives at all CGA State sponsored functions and will receive a sash and a silver buckle. The Queen will receive a buckle, and a cowboy hat tiara at the State Championship Finals 2025 and a rhinestone tiara at Convention 2025.

<u>Check with your family and make sure</u> you are going to attend the State show, The Classics, Jamboree and Convention.

Must be between 14 - 19 years old as of May 1, 2025

Must be a CGA member of good standing for at least 2 years

Must complete the enclosed open book quiz of CGA information with a passing score.

- Wear Appropriate Attire: CGA Dress code including shirt, pants and belt, as well as a cowboy hat/Helmet.
- Always be Respectful to Others.
- To assist all members of CGA in achieving their goals.
- Applicants must not use drugs, alcohol, or foul language at any time.
